The individual managers of NEA 11 GP are M. James Barrett, Peter J. Barris, Forest Baskett, Krishna "Kittu" Kolluri and Scott D. Sandell. The NEA 11 Indirect Reporting Persons disclaim beneficial ownership within the meaning of Section 16 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended, or otherwise of such portion of the NEA 11 shares in which the NEA 11 Indirect Reporting Persons have no pecuniary interest.

3. NEA Partners 11 received 921,000 shares of common stock of the Issuer in the distribution by NEA 11 on June 15, 2015.

4. The shares are directly held by NEA Partners 11 and indirectly held by NEA 11 GP, the sole general partner of NEA Partners 11, and the individual managers of NEA 11 GP (NEA 11 GP (NEA 11 GP and the individual managers of NEA 11 GP together, the "NEA Partners 11 Indirect Reporting Persons"). The individual managers of NEA 11 GP are M. James Barrett, Peter J. Barris, Forest Baskett, Krishna "Kittu" Kolluri and Scott D. Sandell. The NEA Partners 11 Indirect Reporting Persons disclaim beneficial ownership within the meaning of Section 16 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended, or otherwise of such portion of the NEA Partners 11 Indirect Reporting Persons have no pecuniary interest.

5. NEA Partners 11 made a pro rata distribution for no consideration of an aggregate of 921,000 shares of common stock of the Issuer to its limited partners on June 15, 2015.

6. The Baskett Family Trust u/a dtd 10/12/10 (the "Baskett Trust") received 56,359 shares of common stock of the Issuer in the distribution by NEA Partners 11 on June 15, 2015.

The Reporting Person is the trustee of the Baskett Trust, which is the direct beneficial owner of the shares of common stock of the Issuer. The Reporting Person disclaims beneficial ownership within the meaning of Section 16 of the 1934 Act, as amended, or otherwise of such portion of the shares of common stock of the Issuer held by the Baskett Trust in which the Reporting Person has no pecuniary interest.
